Code of conduct

All students are to respect the following guidelines:

1. RESPECT FOR OTHERS AND SCHOOL PROPERTY

- 1.1 All must conduct themselves with courtesy and respect towards staff and students.

3. RULES OF OPERATION

- 3.1 It is forbidden to make a false statement.
- 3.2 The class schedule must be respected. For any change of schedule, please communicate with the reception.

- 3.4 It is forbidden to plagiarize an exam, use a cell phone, a digital tablet or any other electronic device. This may result in failure, suspension or transfer of the student to another center.
- 3.5 If cell phones are allowed in class, they must be put on silent.
- 3.6 Posting or soliciting of the center is prohibited.

4. SECURITY

- 4.1 Only students, staff and authorized persons may access the center.
- 4.2 If the fire alarm rings, follow the instructions of your teacher or authorized personnel.
- 4.3 Any incident that occurs in the center must be immediately reported to the reception.
